FREE RABIES CLINIC FOR CATS AND DOGS – The State of NJ requires that all rabies shots be good through November 1 of the license year. This year's <u>FREE</u> Rabies Clinic is on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>November 4</u>, <u>2017 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM at the Elmer Fire Hall</u>. PLEASE NOTE - NO LICENSES WILL BE ISSUED AT THIS TIME. If your pet's rabies shot expires prior to <u>November 1</u>, <u>2018</u> you will need to get a new rabies shot before you can get a new 2018 pet license.

**DOG & CAT LICENSING** – Animal licensing begins **January 1, 2018** and the deadline to send in your 2018 license payment is **March 31, 2018**. There is a \$20 per pet late fee and possible additional court fines if you pay after **March 31, 2018**. Please check your dog's rabies information now to avoid these additional charges; rabies must be good through **November 1, 2018** for a 2018 license. State statute requires all pets be vaccinated before licenses are issued. License fees are \$10 for spayed/neutered dog, \$15 for unsprayed/unneutered dog, \$10 for spayed/neutered cat, and \$15 for unsprayed/unneutered cat. License payments may be mailed to the Animal Registrar, Elmer Borough, PO Box 882, or dropped in the side door drop box at the bottom of the glass doors on the library entrance side of the building. STORMWATER POLLUTION AND WHAT WE CAN DO ABOUT IT — Water from rain and melting snow that flows over lawns, parking lots and streets is known as stormwater runoff. This water, which travels along gutters, into catch basins and through storm drain pipes and ditches, usually is not treated, but then flows or is discharged into local water bodies. Along the way, the stormwater picks up trash (fast-food wrappers, cigarette butts, Styrofoam cups, etc.) and toxins and other pollutants (gas, motor oil, antifreeze, fertilizers, pesticides and pet droppings). This polluted storm water can kill fish and other wildlife, destroy wildlife habitat, contaminate drinking water sources and force the closing of beaches because of health threats to swimmers. Human activity is largely responsible for the stormwater pollution. Everything that we put on the ground or into the storm drain can end up in our water. Each of us has a responsibility to make sure these contaminants stay out of our water. Please note that our new Rental Registration, Ordinance No. 2017-4, is now in effect and the Housing Officer will be sending out notices soon for compliance. The Ordinance now states that rental properties must be inspected "upon each change or addition of tenant/tenants, or annually, whichever event occurs first".
