

## **Door Knocking Notice**

Valued Elmer residents,

We are excited to inform you that Elmer Borough has partnered with EPA's **Get the Lead Out (GLO) Initiative** to accelerate the verification and plan for the replacement of lead service lines in our borough. To learn more about the **GLO Initiative**, please visit <u>Get the Lead Out Initiative | US EPA</u>.

From **August 19th - August 21st**, we will be in your neighborhood going door-to-door to identify your water service line material. Members of the Elmer Borough government will accompany the GLO team, which will consist of about 4 people wearing fluorescent utility vests and GLO badges with their names.

## Why is this effort important?

Water service lines that contain lead are known to pose health risks especially for children, pregnant women, and older adults. Elmer Borough is working to verify the material of all water service lines in our community to reduce the risk of exposure to lead in drinking water, and we need your cooperation!

## What to expect:

- 1. A knock on your door from two to three of our friendly staff members.
- 2. The staff members will conduct a quick and simple visual inspection of your water service line.
- 3. The staff members will record the material of your water service line.
