ORDINANCE NO. 2025-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMER, SALEM COUNTY, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 12 ENTITLED "FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION" OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMER

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmer have determined that certain amendments to Chapter 12 entitled "Fire Prevention and Protection" are necessary; and

WHEREAS, in all other respects Chapter 12 entitled "Fire Prevention and Protection" shall remain in full force and effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmer, County of Salem and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

SECTION 1. REPEAL THE FOLLOWING:

SECTION 2. REPLACE/AMEND

Title of Chapter 12 shall be entitled "Fire Prevention"

12-1.1 Local Enforcement

Pursuant to Section 11 of the Uniform Fire Safety Act (P.L. 1983, c. 383, N.J.S.A. 52:27D-202), the New Jersey Uniform Fire Code (N.J.A.C. 5:70-1 et seq.) shall be locally enforced in the Borough of Elmer.

12-1.2 Agency Designation

The Local Enforcing Agency shall be the Borough of Elmer Bureau of Fire Prevention which is hereby created therein. The Bureau of Fire Prevention shall hereinafter be known as the Local Enforcing Agency.

12-1.5 Organization

The Local Enforcing Agency established by subsection 12-1.2 of this article shall be under the direct supervision and control of the Fire Official.

12-1.6 Appointments, Term of Office; Removal

a. Appointment and Qualifications of Fire Official. The Fire Official shall be certified by the state and shall be appointed by the Borough Council.

12-1.8 Permit Fees

a. The permit fees established by the Uniform Fire Code shall be charged by the Borough of Elmer for each permit inspection. These charges may be obtained from the Fire Official.

12-1.9 Smoke Detector and Carbon Monoxide Certifications

Smoke detector and carbon monoxide alarms shall be inspected by the Bureau of Fire Prevention within the Borough of Elmer, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:70-4.19 et seq. and certificates of approval with respect to operation thereof shall be issued by the Bureau of Fire Prevention. A fee shall be collected for each inspection as specified in N.J.A.C. 5:70-2.9(d) and placed in the Borough Fire Safety Account.

12-1.10 Board of Appeals

Pursuant to Sections 15 and 17 of the Uniform Fire Safety Act, any person aggrieved by any action of the Local Enforcing Agency shall have the right to appeal to the Construction Board of Appeals of Salem County.

SECTION 3. REPEALER.

All prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.

Each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be an independent section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase, and the finding or holding of any such portion of this Ordinance to be unconstitutional, void, or ineffective for any cause, or reason, shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. WHEN EFFECTIVE.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
